PROSTITUTE LIGHT PROGRAM- Mariani, Haiti is only 6 miles from the epicenter of the devastating earthquake that struck January, 2010. It is also home to the largest and most centrally located Hope Alive! Clinic.



Mariani, Haiti is known for something else that has given it a bad reputation all over Haiti: Prostitution. Prostitution is the only way some women are able to feed their children or themselves. We hope to shine God's light and love through the new "Prostitute Light Program". We really need your prayers and financial support for this program to be successful. It's purpose is to offer Hope to the hopeless through the Gospel message of salvation in Jesus Christ.

Newly converted prostitutes will be encouraged to attend the church of our Assistant Administrator, Pastor Francois, to receive God's continuing love and discipleship. Our staff will work alongside these women and young girls to create alternative business opportunities and obtain school scholarships to sustain them. (One option will be a sewing business through the ministry of Pam Miller.)

Prostitute Light is in keeping with our medical focus, minimizing the spread of STDs. HIV testing will be performed routinely at our Mariani Clinic Laboratory, and HIV positive patients will be treated.

We are excited for this opportunity to reach these folks with the light of God's love.
