The staple foods for this country that can be shipped dry are RICE and LEGUMES (Beans).  
Also, we cannot accept canned items at this time - too heavy and would require can openers.

All medications need to have an expiration date at least 3 months in the future - NO expired medications.  
Store brand and generics are fine. Also, NO aspirin based products please.

Mariani (Grande Saline) Clinic now has a laboratory! Hope Alive! Clinic in Mariani was built in 1998 and opened in 1999.
