IBUPROFEN - infant, child, adult (for example: Motrin, Advil)
MULTI-VITAMINS - infant, child, adult

HYDROCORTIZONE CREAM OR OINTMENT
ANTIBIOTIC CREAM OR OINTMENT
ANTI-FUNGAL CREAM
VAGINAL CREAMS (FOR YEAST INFECTION)
PRESCRIPTION ANTIBIOTICS

FOOD ITEMS: DRY MILK
BOXED (DRY) BABY CEREAL
POWDERED INFANT FORMULA
OTHER DRIED FOODS (EASY TO PREPARE/NO CANS PLEASE)

DRIED BEANS & PEAS
CORN MEAL

SEEDS: FRUIT & VEGETABLE SEEDS THAT GROW IN A TROPICAL CLIMATE

TENTS: Sheets are not waterproof - families are sleeping in the streets & “tent” cities made up of sheets – including Hope Alive! Staff and incoming missionaries. Rainy season is coming!

PLEASE NOTE:

This list is changing frequently as we learn from those ‘in country’ what is required.

All medications need to have an expiration date at least 4 months in the future - NO expired medications.
Also, NO aspirin based products please.

Mariani (Grande Saline) Clinic now has a laboratory! Hope Alive! Clinic in Mariani was built in 1998 and opened in 1999. It is a 10-minute walk up the hill from Le Lambi Hotel, just outside the slum of Carrefour. Numerous Haitians are healed and fed in the Name of Jesus, not only at Mariani, but at each clinic and pharmacy station administered by Hope Alive! The Gospel is shared with all who enter, and many have chosen to “take up their cross and follow Jesus”.
